

K-B supports annual Hinsdale South food drive

King-Bruwaert House staff, residents and family members participated in the annual Hinsdale South High School Food Drive by collecting donations and non-perishable food items for several weeks in late October-November. Teaming up with the Willowbrook-Burr Ridge Chamber of Commerce and the Banana Republic Store in Burr Ridge, K-B was able to collect 320 pounds of food for the campaign. Resident donations of \$175 were also provided to the students who visited the retirement community in Burr Ridge to pick up the food boxes on the final day of the campaign. The annual food drive, sponsored by the Hinsdale South Key Club and the National Honor Society, generated almost 21,000 pounds of food that was distributed to three local food pantries before Thanksgiving. Hinsdale South English teacher Mallory Bauer served as a faculty advisor of the Food Drive.
